



**(IA NO. 904 OF 2018 – Delay in filing Rejoinders)**

We have heard the learned counsel, Ms. Swapna Seshadri appearing for the Appellant.

The learned counsel appearing for the Appellant submitted that, there is a delay of 26 days in filing rejoinder to the reply filed by the Appellant. Further, she submitted that, in the light of the submissions made and the reasoning given in the application, the delay has been explained satisfactorily and sufficient cause has been shown in the application. The same may kindly be accepted and delay in filing rejoinder may kindly be condoned and the instant IAs may kindly be allowed in the interest of justice and equity.

Submission made by the learned counsel appearing for the Appellant, as stated above, is placed on record.
