#### <u>ORDER</u>

## IA No. 729 of 2018 (for condonation of delay in filing reply)

The learned counsel, Mr. Anand K. Ganesan, appearing for second Respondent submitted that there is a delay of 54 days in filing the reply which has been explained satisfactorily and sufficient cause has been made out in the application. The same may kindly be accepted and delay in filing the reply may kindly be condoned.
