ORDER

IA NO. 983 OF 2018

(For Extension of time)

We have heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Appellant and the Respondent. The instant application is filed by the Respondent for seeking extension of time for another six weeks'. The learned counsel appearing for the Respondent further submitted that sufficient reason has been explained in paragraph 7 for seeking extension of time and the instant application may kindly be accepted as a last chance in the interest of justice and equity.

Per contra, the learned counsel appearing for the Appellant contended and submitted that the appropriate Order may be passed

extending the time as a last chance and no further extension of time hereinafter.

Submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for the Respondent and the learned counsel appearing for the Appellant, at supra, are placed on record.

After careful consideration of the submissions of the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Appellant and the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Respondent and perusal of the statement made in para 7 of the application, the Respondent has given the reasons for extension of time for another six weeks for compliance of the order dated 21.07.2017, the same was accepted. Another six weeks time is extended for compliance of the order dated 21.07.2017 as a last chance. No further application will be entertained for extension of time hereinafter.

With these observations, Application is disposed of filed by the Respondent.
