IA NO. 541 OF 2019
(Application for leave to file the appeal)

Mr. Anup Jain appears on behalf of the Respondent DISCOM.

For the reasons stated in the application, leave to file the instant appeal is granted. Application is disposed of.

IA NO. 542 OF 2019
(Application for delay in filing the appeal)

There is 97 days' delay in filing this appeal. In this application, the applicant/appellant has prayed that delay may be condoned.

We have heard learned counsel for the applicant/appellant and perused the explanation offered for the delay in filing the appeal. We find
