### **ORDER**

#### IA NO. 301 OF 2018

(Appl. for exemption from arraying all parties before State Commission as party respondents)

The learned counsel appearing for the Respondent Nos. 1 and 2 may file their respective replies on or before 11.05.2018. Thereafter, the learned counsel appearing for the Appellant may file her rejoinder submission on or before 28.05.2018 after duly serving copy on the other side.
