### **ORDER**

# IA NO. 30 OF 2018 (Appl. for Condonation of Delay in filing)

We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the Appellant and learned counsel appearing for the Respondent Nos 4 to 7. Other respondents, though served, unrepresented.

The learned counsel, Mr. Rajesh Chhetri appearing for the Appellant submitted that there is a delay of 25 days in filing the appeal which has been explained satisfactorily and sufficient cause shown in the application. The same may kindly be accepted and delay may kindly be condoned in the interest of justice and equity.

Per contra, learned counsel, Ms. Sumana Naganand, appearing for Respondent Nos. 4 to 7, inter alia contended and submitted that the delay in filing

the appeal is not explained satisfactorily and sufficient cause has not been shown in the application. Hence, the delay may not be condoned.

Submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for the Appellant and learned counsel appearing for the respondents, as stated above, are placed on record.

In the light of the ground made out in the application by the learned council appearing for the Appellant and after careful perusal of the application, explaining the delay in filing the appeal is satisfactory and sufficient cause shown in the application. The same is accepted and the delay in filing the appeal is condoned. IA, being IA No. 30 of 2018, for delay in filing the appeal is allowed.
