ORDER

Learned counsel for Appellants submits that the agreed tariff was Rs.8.40 per unit. However, the tariff now paid is Rs.4.36 per unit on the ground that the COD was beyond the scheduled date. The delay was due to time consumed for the purpose of conversion of land in terms of Karnataka Land Revenue Act which was accepted by the State Government as well as the Respondent distribution licensee; however, not accepted by the State Commission and on its own (suo moto) proceedings fixed the above said tariff which is causing immense loss and financial burden to the generator. Therefore, they seek for interim direction for payment of tariff at the agreed PPA tariff of Rs.8.40 per unit.

Respondent licensee seeks short date to file objections/reply on main Appeal, so that the main Appeal could be disposed of on merits instead of hearing Interim Application. Time is granted. They may file the same on or before 1.4.2019 with advance copy to the other side, failing which it shall be taken as nil.
