ORDER
(IA NO. 603 OF 2019 - For Directions)

Heard on IA No. 603 of 2019.

This IA refers to payments to be made on the invoices raised by respondent generator from April, 2018 to February, 2019 which comes to Rs.79,50,05,956/-. For earlier period up to March, 2018, on 14.12.2018, on consent of parties, 50% of the claim made therein, was agreed to be paid in three equal monthly installments. Appellant Discom seeks five equal monthly installments commencing from 01.06.2019 so far it relates to the present amount, as mentioned above, (50% of the total claim till February, 2019).

In the light of the above submissions, IA is allowed.

It is made clear that in future, as and when the invoices are raised, 50% of the invoices amount shall be paid without any delay.

It is, further, made clear that the future amounts shall be paid along with installments as directed above.

With these observations, the instant IA stands disposed of.
