<u>ORDER</u>

In this application, the respondent has prayed as follows:

"In the facts and circumstances stated above, the Applicant Board prays that the Hon'ble Tribunal may graciously be pleased to:

- A. Extend the time period of determination of Final Initial Unit Natural Gas Pipeline Tariff of the Agartala (Dukli Maharajganj) pipeline by a period of six [6] weeks from the date of listing of the present application in the interest of justice, equity and fairplay.
- B. Pass any other order that this Hon'ble Tribunal deems fit in the interest of justice."

We have heard the learned counsel for both the parties.
