**ORDER**  
**(IA No. 916 of 2017 – delay in filing)**

There is 354 days' delay in filing this appeal. In this application, the Applicant/Appellant has prayed that delay may be condoned.

We have heard learned counsel for the Applicant/Appellant and perused the explanation offered for the delay in filing the appeal. We find this delay is on account of the fact of the pendency of the review petition before the State Commission. The Review petition was filed within the prescribed period of limitation before the State Commission. The review was disposed of by the State Commission vide order dated 14.07.2017.
