



impugned order and thereafter a direction was given to the local counsel to obtain copy of the judgment and after obtaining copy of the said judgment legal advice was sought and appeal is filed.

We are informed that the appeals involving the similar issues being Appeals Nos. 139 of 2016; 200 of 2016 and 148 of 2016 have already been admitted by this Tribunal. Considering this fact and also considering the fact that the Appellant is a co-operative society, we are of the opinion that delay deserves to be condoned after saddling the appellant with costs. Accordingly, the Appellant is directed to pay the cost of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) to "**National Defence Fund, PAN No: AAAGN0009F, Collection A/c No: 11084239799 with State Bank of India, Institutional Division, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Parliament Street New Delhi**" on or before 24.11.2017. Application is disposed of.

After receiving the compliance report, Registry is directed to number the appeal and list it for admission on **13.12.2017**.
