ORDER IA No. 735 of 2018 (For Condonation of Delay in Filing the Appeal)

The learned counsel, Mr. Ashish Virmani, appearing for the Appellant, submitted that, there is a delay of 131 days in filing the appeal which has been explained satisfactorily in the application and sufficient cause has been shown therein. The delay in filing the appeal is bonafide and unintentional. The delay has been caused due to the circumstances as explained above. Therefore, he submitted that, the delay may kindly be condoned and IA may kindly be allowed. The matter may kindly be heard on merit in the interest of justice and equity.
