ORDER

In pursuance of the orders passed by this Tribunal earlier, it is submitted that a letter has been presented to the Commission with regard to issue of double charge relating to augment charges. According to the Appellant they have not been charged in ARR and collection has been made only from the applicant seeking connection to the distribution mein.

We have heard the learned counsel for the Commission also. It is appropriate to direct the Appellant to file a separate petition before the Commission with regard to the said issue, and the Commission may consider the issue by giving opportunity and pass orders on merits.

Accordingly, the Appeal is disposed of by remanding the matter to consider afresh. The Commission may decide the issue uninfluenced by any of the observations made in the impugned order.
